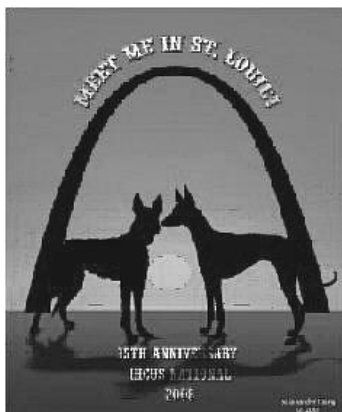

NON-REGULAR (ADDITIONAL) CLASSES (INVOLVING SINGLE DOG ENTRIES)

The following non-regular classes will be provided for both dogs and bitches.

Veteran I Class - For Dogs or Bitches at least seven (7) years of age and under 9 yrs on the day of the show.

Veteran II Class - For Dogs or Bitches at least nine (9) years of age and over on the day of the show.

Lure Coursing Class - For Dogs and Bitches that are Field Trial or Amateur Field Trial Champions or dogs that have placed in ASFA or AKC Trials.

Winners of the above classes are eligible to compete in Best of Breed Competition.

NON-REGULAR (ADDITIONAL) CLASSES (INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES)

Stud Dog Class* - For Stud Dogs and at least two, and not more than four of his Get. Owners of the Stud Dog need not necessarily be owners of the Get. Get must be entered in another class in this show. Stud Dog must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and shown in the ring with his Get. The merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry. Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules.

Brood Bitch Class* - Same as Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

*Chapter 11, Section 8 of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that a neutered male may be entered as a Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed Bitch may be entered as a Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class.

Brace Class - Two dogs/bitches, similar in appearance, performing in unison and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs competing in the brace must have at least one common owner. They need not be entered in any other class.

Open Junior Class: For Boys and Girls at least 9 years and under 12 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present.

Open Intermediate Class: For Boys and Girls at least 12 years and under 15 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present.

Open Senior Class: For Boys and Girls at least 15 years and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present.

SHOW SITE

The Show Site will be available on Wednesday afternoon for move-in. RV's must park on the top tier in the gravel RV lot. Grooming tents will be allowed on Thursday in the lower gravel parking lot. The Show Site will be available to exhibitors at 7:00 am each show day. Dogs must be removed from the show site immediately following completion of the last scheduled class.

No smoking is allowed in any of the Purina Farms building.

Exhibitors must be governed by any rules and regulations of Purina Farms and/or local restriction. Exhibitors must keep dogs under control and restrained at all times. Exhibitors must clean up after their dogs as required. Crating allowed only in designated areas. Dogs not entered at these trials are not allowed on the show grounds. All dogs present must be on leash or confined except with being judged. Failure to comply will result in charges being brought before the Show Committee.

CANADIAN EXHIBITORS MUST SUBMIT ENTRIES WITH CHECKS DRAWN ON U.S. ACCOUNTS OR WITH INTERNATIONAL MONEY ORDERS IN U.S. FUNDS.

FAX Machine entries for this event will be accepted up to closing time. Both sides of the entry form must be submitted. For MasterCard/Visa cardholders only. A \$4.00 FAX entry charge will be added to EACH ENTRY. You must include the cardholder's name, billing address, card number, CVV (from the card reverse), expiration date, signature, phone number and email address (if applicable). If the credit card charge is denied for any reason, an additional service charge will be added. Phone number: (314) 416-4920. This is for FAX entries only. A Recording Fee of 50 cents for each dog and an AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 will be required for each recordable single entry class at any Licensed or Member Club Show or Obedience Trial. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2). These Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club.

RETURNED CHECKS/INVALID CREDIT CARDS do not constitute a valid entry fee. Fees must be paid in guaranteed funds. Checks will not be accepted. The Show Secretary will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check and credit card. Subsequent returned checks and credit card from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.

Entries will be acknowledged after entries close with an entry acknowledgement and judging program mailed to address on entry. (if you wish your Agent to receive an acknowledgement of your entry and/or judging schedule, please submit request with entry, show name and Agent's correct address for this courtesy.) Should exhibitor NOT receive an acknowledgement within a reasonable time, PLEASE notify the Show Secretary by phone (314) 369-7737.

No refund for duplicate entries. No refunds of overpayments totaling \$5.00 or less.

Entry Fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or judge or barred from competition be action of the Show Committee. No entry fees will be refunded if the Show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club or the Show Secretary.

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Entries will not be accepted without fees or signatures. **Changes, additions or corrections** to entry forms must be received in writing or by telegram prior to close of entries. Those received by telephone are not acceptable. **Errors on Entry Blanks.** Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

TROPHIES

All trophies must be claimed the day of the show - None will be mailed. The club reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value.

ADDITIONAL SHOW RULES

Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging. Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its Show Secretary will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class Judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. **Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.**

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

MO State Law requires all dogs over four (4) months of age be current on rabies vaccination.

No Double handling will be permitted at these Show, and attempts to do so from outside the ring will be subject to action by the Show Committee.

The American Kennel Club Rules and Regulations will govern these Show. Exhibitors must make themselves familiar with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany these Show Premium List. The Show Committee reserves the right to make such other regulations as they may deem necessary (not to conflict with AKC rules) on the day of the show. The judging procedure may be modified to accommodate disabled handlers.

Chapter 2, Section 26, Obedience Regulations— "There will be no intensive nor abusive training of dogs on the grounds or premises at a AKC licensed or member obedience trial or sanctioned match." This rule will be strictly enforced; violators will be subject to a Trial Committee hearing.

The Ibizan Hound Club of the United States does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form for these events.

LOSS OR DAMAGE

The Show Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs, and their property, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability, in the event of any accident or misfortune due to entering dogs or exhibitors participating in these Show.
