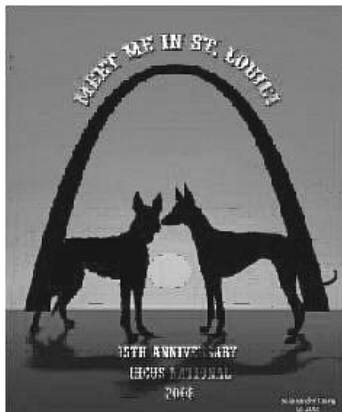

Directions from Purina Farms: Take Hwy I-44 East to Big Bend Rd. Turn right on Big Bend. The Emergency Clinic is at 9937 Big Bend Road, on the left hand side.

ROUTES TO THE SHOW

I-44 From East or West - Take Gray Summit exit (Hwy 100 E, mile marker 264) Turn North on Hwy 100 E. Go approximately ½ mile to "MM" & turn left. There are small Purina signs on the corner. "MM" is a very winding road. Large vehicles - use care. Entrance to the Farm is about 1 mile on the left. There are large security gates. The Lure Coursing Field is beyond the conformation show site. Signs will be posted.

ELIGIBLE BREEDS AND REGISTRY: Only purebred Afghan Hounds, Basenjis, Borzois, Greyhounds, Ibizan Hounds, Irish Wolfhounds, Italian Greyhounds, Pharaoh Hounds, Rhodesian Ridgebacks, Salukis, Scottish Deerhounds and Whippets that are one year of age or older, that have been registered with The American Kennel Club, or part of an AKC-registered litter, or otherwise, if whelped outside of the United States of America and owned by a resident of the USA, or of a country with a foreign registry organization whose pedigrees are acceptable for AKC registration and is registered with that registry, or that have been granted an Indefinite Listing Privilege (ILP), and Sighthounds eligible to compete in the conformation Miscellaneous Class are eligible to participate in lure coursing tests and trials and be awarded the prefix title of Field Champion and the suffix titles of Junior Courser, Senior Courser or Master Courser. Hounds may not be entered as "registration pending" or "ILP pending."

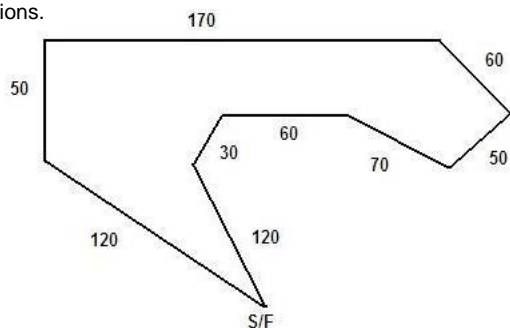
Sloughis 1 year of age or older, that have been recorded with the Foundation Stock Service (FSS), or that have been granted an Indefinite Listing Privilege (ILP) are eligible to enter Lure Coursing Tests.

JC TEST: A hound running alone shall receive certification from a Judge on one date, and a second certification from a different Judge at a later date, stating that the hound completed a 600-yard course with a minimum of four (4) turns. The hound must complete the course with enthusiasm and without interruption. The two runs can be on the same date at or in conjunction with a National Breed Specialty.

GENERAL INFORMATION:

1. All entries must be one year of age or older on the date of the test.
2. Hounds not present at the time of roll call will be scratched after a 5-minute grace period. Each entry will be examined at inspection for breed disqualifications. Bitches in season and hounds determined to be lame, unfit to compete, or to have breed disqualifications by the Inspection Committee or owner at the time of roll call, or upon previous notification by the owner, shall be barred from competition and their entry fees shall be refunded. Spayed and neutered hounds, without breed disqualifications, are eligible to participate.
3. Battery powered continuous loop machines will be used. Lure will consist of white plastic bags. Backup equipment will be available.
4. The course will be reversed for the second runs.
5. Please bring your own shade and water.
6. The owner or handler entering a hound in a test or trial does so at his or her own risk and agrees to assume responsibility for any damage to facilities or persons, caused by him or her or by his or her hound(s). He or she also agrees to abide by all of the Rules and Regulations of The American Kennel Club.
