### SHOW SITE AND GROUNDS

The show site will be available to exhibitors at 12 noon on Thursday, June 3, 2010. Overnight parking will be in designated spaces only on the gravel or blacktop lots above the show grounds.

### JUDGING

Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring. It is the responsibility of the owner or his agent to have the dog ready to be shown and at the ring entrance when the steward calls for the class. It is not the responsibility of the Club, ring steward or show secretary to locate any dog, its owner or its agent. Judges need not wait for late dogs. Ramps may be used in emergency situations. (In an emergency situation, an exhibitor has the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund.)

### LOSS OR DAMAGE

The Soft Coated Wheaten Terrier Club of Greater St. Louis, the Show Secretary, Purina Farms and their agents or employees assume NO responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or spectators or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. It is expressly understood that every dog at this show is in the care, custody and control of his owner or agent during the entire time the dog is on the show premises. Children are expected to be under the control of their parent or guardian at all times. All persons attending this dog show hereby waive any claim for damages against the Club or its members in the event a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from overheating or suffocation due to improper ventilation.

The Soft Coated Wheaten Terrier Club of Greater St. Louis does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form for these events.

### PRIZES

Prizes (trophies) and sweepstakes money will be awarded in the judging ring to the person exhibiting the dog who will be assumed to be the owner or agent of the owner. Claims for trophies must be made in the ring before the judging of the breed is over and the Show Secretary advised at once. All trophies must be claimed the day of the show. None will be mailed. The Club reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value.

### OTHER

This show is governed by the American Kennel Club. Exhibitors should be familiar with AKC rules and read the AKC agreement on the back of the entry blank in this premium list. Exhibitors will be responsible for all charges they incur for veterinary services provided by the on-call veterinarian. Any damage to motels by exhibitors can result in disciplinary action by a bench show committee.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

A Recording Fee of 50 cents for each dog and an AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 will be required for each recordable single entry class at any Licensed or Member Club Show or Obedience Trial. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2). These Fees are collected by the show giving club and paid to the American Kennel Club.

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance.

**Unsigned Entries cannot be accepted.** Entries not on official AKC Entry Forms and Photocopies of Entry Forms without Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are NOT ACCEPTABLE. (Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 11, Section 4) Returned checks or invalid credit cards do not constitute a valid entry fee. Entries will not be accepted without fees.

Changes, additions or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing prior to the close of entries. Those received by telephone are not acceptable. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms and no entry fee will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. This includes entering a dog in a class in which the dog is not eligible to compete or entering the same dog twice.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by veterinarian or judge or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee.
