A Recording Fee of 50 cents and \$1.50 AKC Event Service Fee will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show or Obedience Trial or Tracking Event. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the Fees are to be collected on the first entry only. (Chapter 11, Section 2 of the AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows). A \$3.00 AKC Recording Fee will be required for each entry in Rally. (Chapter 1, Section 3 of the AKC Rally Regulations.) Recording Fees and Event Service Fees are to be collected by the show-giving club and paid to the American Kennel Club.

Move-ups will be allowed per AKC regulations.

CANADIAN EXHIBITORS MUST SUBMIT ENTRIES WITH CHECKS DRAWN ON U.S. ACCOUNTS OR WITH INTERNATIONAL MONEY ORDERS IN U.S. FUNDS.

There will be no refund for duplicate entries.

RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Show Secretary will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.

Entry Fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or judge or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee. No entry fees will be refunded if the Show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club or the Show Secretary.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Entries will not be accepted without fees or signatures.

Changes, additions or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing or by electronic means (FAX, Email) prior to close of entries. Those received by telephone are not acceptable.

Errors on Entry Blanks. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellations of entries after the published closing date.

The show giving Club, the Show Secretary, their agents, employees, etc, assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assume no responsibility for injury to children.

The White River Golden Retriever Club, Inc. does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the official AKC Entry Form.

Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging.

Dogs allowed in rings during judging only.

The Club reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value. All trophies must be claimed the day of the show - None will be mailed.

SPECIAL INFORMATION

We will have one conformation ring, crating space & grooming in the Commercial Building. One obedience/rally ring & crating space will be in the adjacent building. **NO DOGS MAY BE LEFT IN THESE BUILDINGS OVERNIGHT.** Diagram of Fairgrounds will be sent with judging programs to show unloading areas, etc.

It is the policy of the White River Golden Retriever Club that the Show Chairman will not handle any dogs in any competitive class at the WRGRC Specialty. Family members of the chairman may handle dogs in any class, and dogs co-owned by the chairman may be shown if handled by someone other than the chairman. All other club members, including members of the Show Committee, are free to handle dogs in any class at this show.

GRADUATE NOVICE CLASS - For dogs that have earned a CD but have not been certified by a judge to have received a third Qualifying score towards a CDX title prior to the closing of entries. Dogs entered in Graduate Novice may also be entered in one of the Novice or Open classes. Exercises for this class are: *Open Heel Free, Graduate Novice Moving Stand and Examination, Moving Drop on Recall, Dumbbell Recall, Recall Over Broad Jump, Open Long Down (3 Minutes)*.

VETERANS CLASS - For dogs that have an obedience title and are seven (7) years or older on the date of the trial. May be entered in any regular obedience class. The exercises will be performed and judged as in the Novice class.

VERSATILITY - For dogs capable of performing Utility exercises. Six exercises will be performed, two each from the Novice, Open and Utility classes. Need not be handled by the owner. May be entered in any regular obedience class. Each handler shall provide a dumbbell, scent discrimination articles & directed retrieve gloves.

The handler of a Sweepstakes exhibit must be limited to the owner, co-owner, breeder, or a member of their immediate family as they are listed on file with the American Kennel Club as of the closing date for the show for which the Sweepstakes entry is being made. 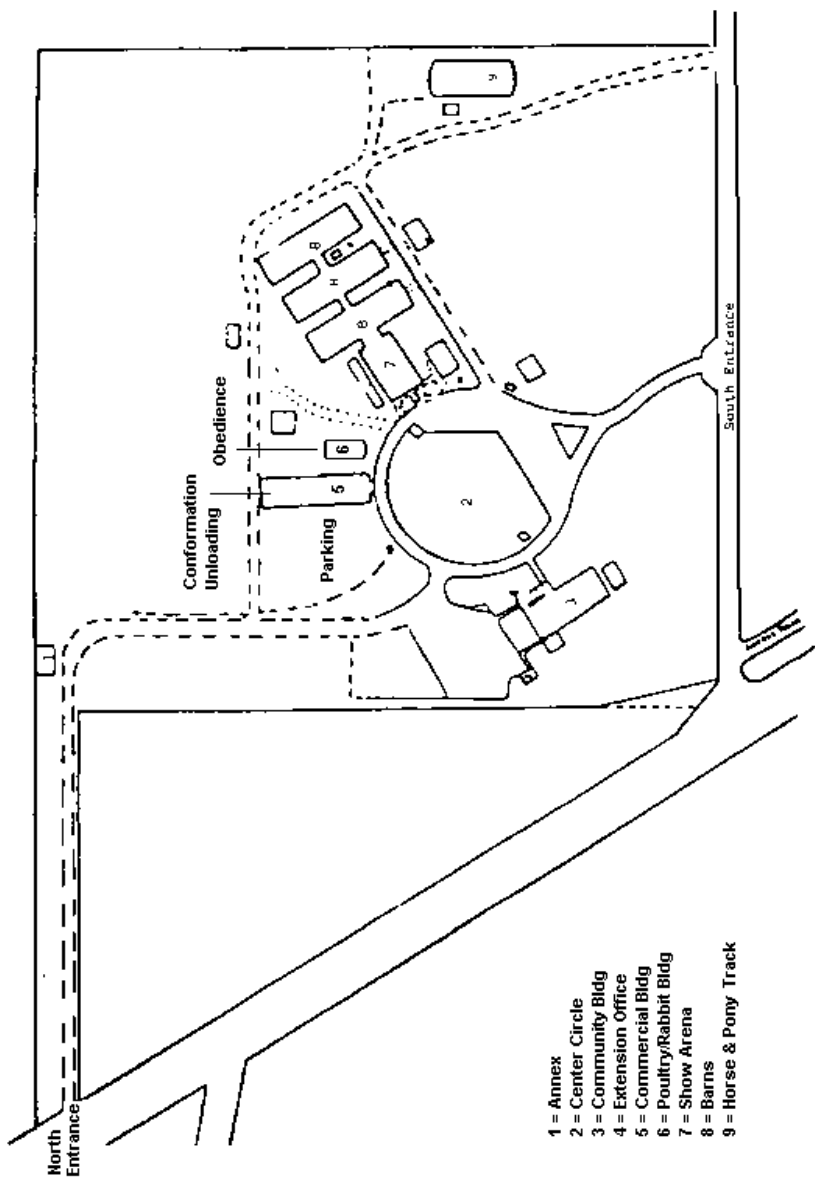
